### **Air Traffic Control Tower Operation**

- Operations count: July 7,721; August 8,003    May 7<sup>th</sup> – August: 29,180  
Daily average: 317    Monthly average: 7,295  
Local operations 51%    IFR operations 11%
- ATIS: pending FAA approval to test new ATIS/ASOS switch at CXO177
- Pilot Controlled Lighting RW 14-32 w/MALSRs now 124.125
- Airport information now current in Airports Facility Directory

### **Runway 14-32 Extension**

- Project implementation meeting with TxDot was held on July 1<sup>st</sup> in Austin
- Property appraisals for land acquisition are completed
- RFP for engineering/design expected to be released in Nov 2009
- Engineering/design 2010 and will include some taxiway reconstruction
- Funding is programmed to be available for construction in FY 2012
- Publication of RNAV/GPS approaches for RW 1-19 is November 2010

### **Perimeter Fence and Camera Projects**

- Fence project underway by National Fence Company
- Camera project: contract going to Commissioners Court Sept. 28<sup>th</sup>

### **Routine Airport Maintenance Projects (RAMP 2009)**

- Detention basin grade restoration – completed with in-house personnel and Precinct 2 assistance
- Drainage improvement along Taxiway EE completed
- Pavement Maintenance Plan – project completed and delivered
- Pavement crack sealing 90% completed to be followed by taxiway re-marking
- Pavement repairs completed

### **Active Development Projects**

- Ballard –2<sup>nd</sup> hangar development – pending design
- Atkinson hangar – construction underway
- RFP 1.77 acres on Taxiway EE awarded to Charles Ballard for development of 6 executive box hangars
