1. 12/3/84 #33 Approve the use of un-coated Aluminized Steel Type II CSP as an equal alternate to reinforced concrete pipe for use in storm sewers and include concrete lining of CSP in storm sewer applications.
2. 10/14/85 2(C) Addendum to Montgomery County Subdivision Rules and Regulations (MCSR&R) in regard to the acceptance of Gypsum Aggregate as road building material.
3. 5/1/89 #11 Adopt the revision to MCSR&R to require three (3) mylar copies of all subdivision plats to be submitted to Commissioners Court.
4. 4/2/90 #30 Approve the revision to MCSR&R for the Drainage Criteria Manual to become a portion of the Subdivision Rules and Regulations.
5. 5/14/90 #20 Order approved for the Drainage Criteria Manual to be incorporated into the MCSR&R.
6. 5/29/90 #22 Order approved amending the Surveying Requirements for subdivisions, requiring staking of subdivision on the ground and revised the required surveyors certificate to be affixed to each plat tendered for recording under the Regulations.

8. 10/21/91 #12 Addendum approved for MCSR&R to allow the use of N-12 Storm Drain Pipe in construction of Subdivision Roads.
9. 12/3/91 #13 Addendum approved for MCSR&R to require the Striping of roads be part of the developers road construction requirements.
10. 10/19/92 #16 Addendum approved for MCSR&R for developers to included in their construction plans the location of speed limit signs, said locations to be approved by the County Engineers office and installation of said signs shall be in accordance with Texas MUTCD.
11. 12/14/92 #28 Amendment approved for MCSR&R for concerning the requirements for submission of test results on HMAC.

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12. 12/21/92 #18 Addendum approved for MCSR&R for roads accepted into county road maintenance system by Prescriptive Rights.

14. 4/12/93 #19 Addendum approved to MCSR&R for the use of Crushed Concrete as an aggregate for Cement Stabilized Base.

16. 7/12/93 #37 Addendum approved to MCSR&R for the use of Cement Stabilized Sand backfill on all new driveway culvert installations and require developers or others who construct sidewalks or hike and bike trails on public R.O.W. to construct in compliance with Americans With Disabilities Act.
17. 3/14/94 #16 Addendum approved to MCSR&R governing the installation of utilities on county road right-of-ways to require that the depth of underground communication lines be buried a minimum depth of 24" below natural ground.

19. 12/4/95 #5 Addendum approved to MCSR&R for the deletion of one course surface treatment as an acceptable surface on County Roads.
